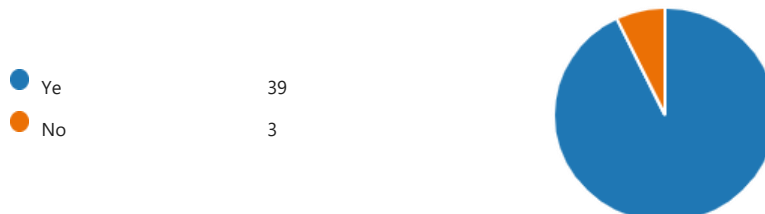


## Appendix A

Not aware of dogs being an issue
Dog fouling remains an issue so removing the PSPO without any further intervention would be a mistake.
Dog fouling is a big problem
I agree but need to see more enforcement to back it up
Dog fouling is a nuisance especially in the area around Alexandra Palace
Haringey has dirty streets, full of litter and dog mess. We need every tool possible to deal with this, including this PSPO. But we also need much more signage and education to tackle irresponsible dog ownership. The PSPO on its own is insufficient.

I support control of dogs.

Yes, but enforcement is needed, and fixed term penalties of £100 are no longer enough. Dog fouling is rife where we are and has got significantly worse in the last 1-2 years.
This seems like an appropriate way to tackle dog fouling in the area
These should be in place to help control public drinking, which is problematic in some areas. But, in my experience, these are not effectively enforced. In Bruce Grove, people frequently drink in the PSPO area, and even sometimes underneath the sign saying that it's a PSPO area, and nothing seems to be done about it.
Lots of dog poo around and see some badly behaved dogs off leads.
Some dogs have been shown to act aggressively towards other dogs. I have seen instances where dogs who were not on leads were attacking other dogs - and the owners were unable to call them back.
Yes. This is important to maintain. Would also like the opportunity to expand ladder wide.
I support the reduction and prevention of crime associated with the commissioning of PSPOs.
It is important for the council and police to have the power to ensure that dog owners are acting responsibly, and if not be able to take action.
Too many uncontrolled dogs not in leads in Bruce Castle Park

There are persistent problems in Haringey with respect to dog fouling, dogs not on leashes, dogs in prohibited areas (playgrounds), etc.. Much more enforcement is needed in this area.

I don't want a gap

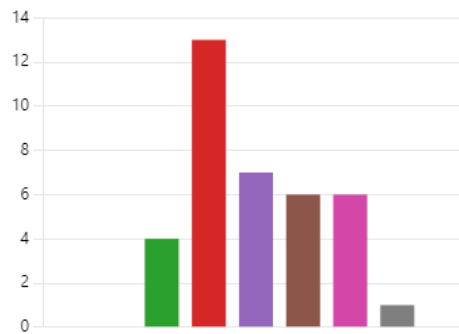
Have been attacked at least twice by dogs even on leads! too many dogs now in parks.

Some time ago in Finsbury Park I managed to dive and pick up our small terrier, with only a second to spare, who was about to be attacked by a staffi with studded collar whose owners had let go of its lead and didn't seem to be concerned, in fact threatened me when I tried to engage with them. Also, too much un-picked up dog faeces in Haringay Passage and elsewhere.

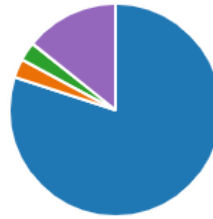

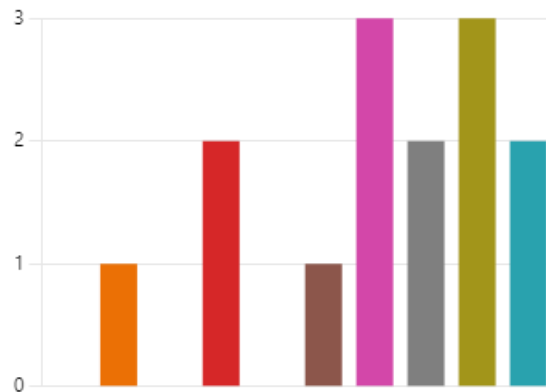
