Have your say on Tottenham's Future

The riots in August had a major impact on local community and business confidence. We at Haringey Council have done a huge amount since then to help the local community recover.

We have been visiting local businesses to offer them advice and support and we have introduced business rate relief for all affected businesses. Working with local businesses we also launched the 'I Love Tottenham' campaign to restore pride and confidence in the High Road. A programme of activities is planned in the run up to Christmas to ensure a successful Christmas for our traders.

Planning work is already underway for the damaged and destroyed sites on the High Road to get them reoccupied and reopened as soon as possible. We will also ensure that schemes are of the highest quality and designed with the best long-term future of the High Road in mind.

What you've already told us

We know you want Tottenham to be a place where people are proud to live, work, invest and stay throughout their lifetimes – and so do we. However, transforming Tottenham is an enormous challenge and one that can only be achieved by the Council and its partner organisations working with you to meet the challenges this brings.

Our conversations since the summer tell us that people want:

- Safe, secure and confident communities
- Thriving businesses and more jobs
- High quality housing
- Excellent public space and transport
- More investment in Tottenham

Local communities, businesses and stakeholders have also told us that we should focus attention initially on four key priority areas in Tottenham: Northumberland Park, Tottenham Green, Tottenham Hale and the High Road. This does not mean that other areas of Tottenham will be excluded from change and improvement – we are determined to transform Tottenham as a whole and provide new opportunities for the whole community.


What's next for Tottenham
