


MAP 1: New River Village proposed £1 Million Section 106 allocation

SOCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE CONTRIBUTION

£1,219,000 spent on the acquisition of land and the subsequent construction and build out of the new Heartlands High secondary school.

CAMPSBOURNE ESTATE

250,000 spent within Estate:

£124,000 spent on Landscaping to Estate Grounds at Wat Tyler House & Harvey House
£60,000 spent on new changing rooms/toilets to Campsbourne Junior School football pitch for evening recreational activities for young people
£50,000 spent on new play space at 'Red Square' in Campsbourne
£16,000 committed to new community allotment on Campsbourne Car Park

PENSTOCK PATH

£75,000.00 spent on improved footway, lighting and bridge widening.

SOCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE CONTRIBUTION

£800,000.00 spent on acquisition of 85, Marsh Lane, N17 to enable the relocation of Weston Park Depot recycling centre in the Haringey Heartlands inline with one of the objectives from the Haringey Heartlands Development Framework.

OFF-SITE AFFORDABLE HOUSING

£925,000.00 spent on the purchase and repair of properties within the borough for affordable housing purposes.

STATION ROUTE IMPROVEMENTS

£45,000.00 spent on footways, lighting and a zebra crossing

HORNSEY HIGH STREET REGENERATION

£400,000.00 in total spent:

£278,000 spent on Rectory Gardens Landscaping
£102,000 spent on Shop front heritage improvements (match funding by English Heritage)
£20,000 spent on Restoration of Hornsey Church tower

HORNSEY STATION IMPROVEMENTS

£25,000.00 spent on improved lighting, fencing and platform furniture.
(match funding by First Capital Connect trains).
