Re: New premises license

Please find the following statement on how I will address the prevention of public nuisance from:

1. Noise generated by patrons in external areas of the premises.

There are notices (in three different languages) displayed in external areas of the premises to recognise the residential nature of the area and to keep the voice to minimum when seated outside (front and rear). (Please see the attached photos). The patrons will be reminded often to conduct their behaviour accordingly, staff will be trained and have the right to ask patrons to move inside the premise or leave if it felt that they could be disturbing the neighbours. The external rear smoking area will be closed and patrons will be asked to come inside the main structure of the premises at 20:00 hrs. My self and the staff will be reminding the patrons the importance of being quiet anywhere in the premises in order to prevent the public nuisance. Policies to ban any customer who does not comply with our rules and policies.

2. Noise from patrons exiting the premises.

There are notices displayed near the main front door to remind the patrons to leave the premises quietly to avoid disturbing the local residents. My self and the staff will be reminding the patrons about the importance of leaving the premises quietly and not disturbing the neighbours.

3. Noise from plant and machinery.

All machinery will be correctly maintained and regularly serviced to ensure that they operate efficiently and with no disturbance to neighbours. All I have in the premises is dishwasher, ice maker, coffee espresso machine, coffee bean grinder and two fridges and they are placed within the main structure of the premises.

4. Light nuisance.

The illuminated external signage will be switched off when the premises is closed. All lights will be off when closed.

Re: I would like the number of persons permitted to utilise the frontage to be restricted to twelve people.
