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1. Describe the issue under consideration

- 1.1 Registered Providers are independent not for profit organisations that provide a range of housing services (including social rented housing, supported housing and shared ownership) to help meet local housing needs. Some also offer a range of extended services to support individual tenants and the communities in which they live, such as employment training, youth work and estate services.
- 1.2 As Registered Providers are important local partners, it is essential that local authorities develop strong and effective partnerships with these organisations to support the delivery of local public services.
- 1.3 At present, there are approximately sixty Registered Providers that own or manage social housing in Haringey. Although such a broad range of providers can help to meet the diverse housing needs of the borough, the number of providers presents challenges to the Council and the Registered Providers (RPs).
