Adults and Health Scrutiny Panel – Scrutiny Cafe Priority List

Local Provision / transformation to new model (11 votes), to include:

- Governance arrangements (including Care Quality Commission etc)
- Co-production (including signposting and commissioning)
- Transition (release from hospitals to community)
- Integration
- Personal budgets

To include the users' voice

Isolation (4 votes), to include:

- Neighbourhood connect

Enablement (4 votes), to include:

- Self-help
- Mental health (devolution pilot)
- Use of technology to promote independence

Public Health (3 votes), such as:

- Obesity
- Alcohol (and issue can be tackled outside the criminal justice system)
- Smoking
- Gambling (link to economic issues, devolution pilot)

Safeguarding (3 votes), linking to enablement and including:
