2. IMPROVING PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN CROUCH END, HORNSEY AND STROUD GREEN

- a) Larry Heyman will speak on behalf of the railway company 'First Connect' about plans to improve the safety and amenities at Hornsey and Harringay Stations.
- b) Nicos Constantinou will speak on behalf of Haringey Council's Street Scene Service about planned improvements to Tottenham Lane to make safer the approach to Hornsey Station, including a proposed zebra crossing and improvements to street lighting.
