If one or both of the parties fails to attend, the Chair decides whether to: grant an adjournment to another date, or (ii) proceed in the absence of the non-attending party. Normally, an absent party will be given one further chance to attend. **TOPIC HEADINGS** 5. The Chair suggests the "topic headings" for the hearing. In the case of the majority of applications for variation of hours, or other terms and conditions, the main topic is: Whether the extensions of hours etc. applied for would conflict with the four licensing objectives i.e. (i) the prevention of crime and disorder, (ii) public safety, (iii) the prevention of public nuisance, and the protection of children from harm. 



These three males have all been identified as the applicant's cousins.

Hasan KOC has previously come to notice on several occasions for a variety of offences including traffic matters, Possession of cannabis, Supplying cannabis, Breach of dispersal, Burglary and other theft offences.

Naver Engin KOC has also previously come to notice to Police for the following Burglary, Possession of cannabis with the intent to supply (for which he was sentenced to nine months imprisonment) and possession of cannabis.

Aslan KOC who also has previously come to notice for breach of a dispersal notice.

The presence of the above three males and their associates in and around GROVE PARK ROAD/WEST GREEN ROAD N15 have led to the implementation of a dispersal zone within the south side of our ward. These males whilst not having any connection with 98 WEST GREEN ROAD N15 use the location as a meeting/greeting point and deal drugs from outside the location.

I have a great concern that due to a family connection to 143-145 PHILIP LANE N15 and that this area falls outside the current dispersal zone these males will relocate their operations to this venue. I would like to take this opportunity to raise my objection against the issue of this licence on the grounds of crime and disorder. I believe the issue of a licence at these premises will lead to the increase in antisocial behaviour in and around the area with a general increase in local crime such as motor vehicle crime, burglary, robbery and theft offences as the associates of the above males are attracted to the area by their presence.




