<b>LICENSING SUB-COMMITTEE HEARINGS PROCEDURE SUMMARY</b>	
<b>INTRODUCTION</b>	
1.	The Chair introduces himself and invites other Members, Council officers, Police, Applicant and Objectors to do the same.
2.	The Chair invites Members to disclose any prior contacts (before the hearing) with the parties or representations received by them
3.	The Chair explains the procedure to be followed by reference to this summary which will be distributed.
<b>NON-ATTENDANCE BY PARTY OR PARTIES</b>	
4.	If one or both of the parties fails to attend, the Chair decides whether to:
	(i) grant an adjournment to another date, or
	(ii) proceed in the absence of the non-attending party.
	Normally, an absent party will be given one further chance to attend.
<b>TOPIC HEADINGS</b>	
5.	The Chair suggests the "topic headings" for the hearing. In the case of the majority of applications for variation of hours, or other terms and conditions, the main topic is:
	<b>Whether the extensions of hours etc. applied for would conflict with the four licensing objectives i.e.</b>
	(i) the prevention of crime and disorder,
	(ii) public safety,
	(iii) the prevention of public nuisance, and
	(iv) the protection of children from harm.
6.	The Chair invites comments from the parties on the suggested topic headings and decides whether to confirm or vary them.
<b>WITNESSES</b>	
7.	The Chair asks whether there are any requests by a party to call a witness and decides any such request.
8.	Only if a witness is to be called, the Chair then asks if there is a request by an opposing party to "cross-examine" the witness. The Chair then decides any such request.
<b>DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE</b>	
9.	The Chair asks whether there are any requests by any party to introduce late documentary evidence.
10.	If so, the Chair will ask the other party if they object to the admission of the late documents.
11.	If the other party do object to the admission of documents which have only been produced by the first party at the hearing, then the documents shall not be admitted.

12.	If the other party object to documents produced late but before the hearing, the following criteria shall be taken into account when the Chair decides whether or not to admit the late documents:	
(i)	What is the reason for the documents being late?	
(ii)	Will the other party be unfairly taken by surprise by the late documents?	
(iii)	Will the party seeking to admit late documents be put at a major disadvantage if admission of the documents is refused?	
(iv)	Is the late evidence really important?	
(v)	Would it be better and fairer to adjourn to a later date?	
<b>THE LICENSING OFFICER'S INTRODUCTION</b>		
13.	The Licensing Officer introduces the report explaining, for example, the existing hours, the hours applied for and the comments of the other Council Services or outside official bodies. This should be as "neutral" as possible between the parties.	
14.	The Licensing Officer can be questioned by Members and then by the parties.	
<b>THE HEARING</b>		
15.	This takes the form of a discussion led by the Chair. The Chair can vary the order as appropriate but it should include:	
(i)	an introduction by the Objectors' main representative	
(ii)	an introduction by the Applicant or representative	
(iii)	questions put by Members to the Objectors	
(iv)	questions put by Members to the Applicant	
(v)	questions put by the Objectors to the Applicant	
(vi)	questions put by the Applicant to the Objectors	
<b>CLOSING ADRESSES</b>		
16.	The Chair asks each party how much time is needed for their closing address, if they need to make one.	
17.	Generally, the Objectors make their closing address before the Applicant who has the right to the final closing address.	
<b>THE DECISION</b>		
18.	Members retire with the Committee Clerk and legal representative to consider their decision including the imposition of conditions.	
19.	The decision is put in writing and read out in public by the Committee Clerk once Members have returned to the meeting.

I am the above named Officer currently attached to **TOTTENHAN GREEN Safer Neighbour Hood Team** within the London Borough of Haringey, a position I have held for the last two years. The ward of **TOTTENHAM GREEN** covers the area of **WEST GREEN ROAD, LAWRENCE ROAD** and **PHILIP LANE N15** amongst others.

I am making this statement in response to a recent application for an alcohol licence to be granted at **143-145 PHILIP LANE N15** in order for the opening of a Turkish Social Centre named '**BAR BARAN**'. The location of this premises used to be run as a public house '**BOTANY BAY**' until closing down a number of years ago. The down stairs premise has seen been opened as a 24 hours supermarket and this request relates to the upper floors of the premises.

The area of which this address is known for the distribution of drugs, namely cannabis and has suffered an increase in street dealers operating within the area since the closure of other so called 'cannabis cafes' such as '**SHERIN POUND SHOP**' **202 PHILIP LANE N15** which is directly opposite this location. The junction between **LAWRENCE ROAD** and **PHILIP LANE N15** at which **143-145 PHILIP LANE** is situated is a prominent red light area and is frequented at all time of day and night by both males and females who are known to Police for the possession of drugs and drug related offences.

I have been made aware that a male by the name of **Hasan KOC** has applied for a licence to sell alcohol covering **143-145 PHILIP LANE N15** and have great concerns of the issue of such a licence. I have spoke with Mr **Hasan KOC** and voiced my concerns; he has stated that he is aware that certain family members may be involved in the supply of drugs although states that these people will have no connection to the premises.

Historically **WEST GREEN ROAD N15** has had a reputation for the dealing of drugs namely cannabis especially '**ARTIME Social Centre**' **116 WEST GREEN ROAD N15** which was involved in the selling of cannabis over a long period prior to being closed down by **TOTTENHAM GREEN SNT**. At the same time as the closure of '**ARTIME Café**' a Turkish Snooker Centre was reopened at **98 WEST GREEN ROAD N15** and since this time the

These three males have all been identified as the applicant's cousins.

Hasan KOC has previously come to notice on several occasions for a variety of offences including traffic matters, Possession of cannabis, Supplying cannabis, Breach of dispersal, Burglary and other theft offences.

Naver Engin KOC has also previously come to notice to Police for the following Burglary, Possession of cannabis with the intent to supply (for which he was sentenced to nine months imprisonment) and possession of cannabis.

Aslan KOC who also has previously come to notice for breach of a dispersal notice.

The presence of the above three males and their associates in and around GROVE PARK ROAD/WEST GREEN ROAD N15 have led to the implementation of a dispersal zone within the south side of our ward. These males whilst not having any connection with 98 WEST GREEN ROAD N15 use the location as a meeting/greeting point and deal drugs from outside the location.

I have a great concern that due to a family connection to 143-145 PHILIP LANE N15 and that this area falls outside the current dispersal zone these males will relocate their operations to this venue. I would like to take this opportunity to raise my objection against the issue of this licence on the grounds of crime and disorder. I believe the issue of a licence at these premises will lead to the increase in antisocial behaviour in and around the area with a general increase in local crime such as motor vehicle crime, burglary, robbery and theft offences as the associates of the above males are attracted to the area by their presence.

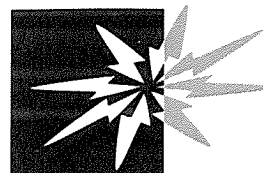

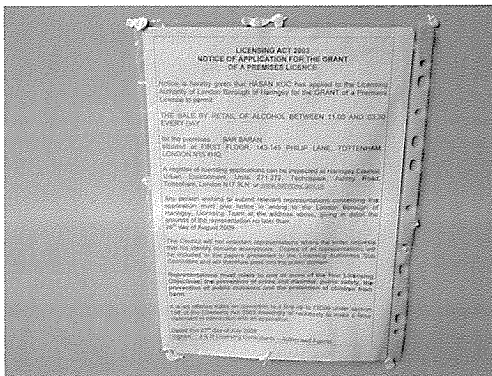
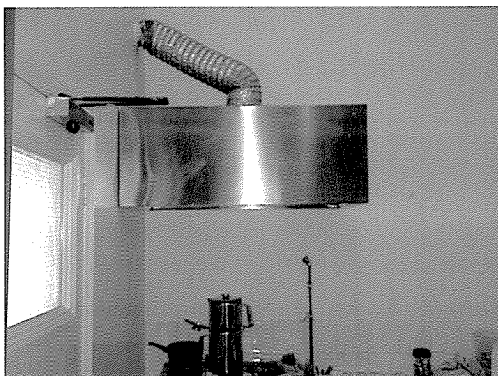
