CCTV shall be installed, operated and maintained in agreement with the police. The system will enable frontal identification of every person entering the premises. The system shall record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept for a minimum of 31 days. Thank you very much for keeping us in the loop with the progress of our representation, I appreciate it.

We will be keeping our representation on file and attending the meeting, when it comes up.

While it is true that the late nights were held when the cafe was owned by another owner, what was not mentioned in their response, is that the former owner and the current owner are partners and they were both working there and running the business, when the late nights were held. We were told then, that the events would not go past nine or nine thirty, yet they often went past midnight and there were not only 2, there were several.

I also want the street to be thriving, I am the owner of the shop right next door to the cafe, Arts And Vintage 263 Archway Road. We/I and my shop are also an important part of the community. We are members of and participate in many local events, from Fair On The Square, to local church, retirement home and HSLI events. We support and regularly donate to local charities, this neighbourhood is very important to me, I am an active business owner and resident.

While the current owner and the last owner do live behind, (not next door), to their cafe, that flat was properly insulated, when it was converted from a shop, to a flat. The ceiling and floor, between the cafe and our flat was not, nor is there any double glazing and my flat's windows are directly above the cafe's windows. The cafe does not affect us currently, because until 3 weeks ago, they closed at 6pm, while I close at 7pm, so I was home, well after they had closed.

Sadly, my experience with what the owners of the cafe is that what they say and what they do, is not always the same thing.

Even the way the notice of application for the alcohol license was improperly displayed is an example. They were aware that I was worried about more late nights and about alcohol being served, because I had so many problems, when it happened last time. I believe they hoped for us not to notice, otherwise, why not display it properly?
