There was agreement that an update should be sought from the Cabinet Member for Communities with regard to this.</p> <p>There was agreement that the presentation given by Matthew Creber on the work being undertaken by the Friends of Tottenham Green group had been useful and that local Ward Members should make contact with the group.</p>

OBCB97.	<p>UPDATE ON ISSUES RAISED AT THE PREVIOUS MEETING</p> <p>The Committee received a report that provided an update on issues raised at the previous meeting and the following points were made:</p> <p><u>Living and Learning in Tottenham</u> The discussion topic at this meeting was: 'Living and Learning in Tottenham' and the key issue arising from this had been the need to identify ways of improving the relationship between the Police and young people. It was suggested that one way of improving understanding may be to hold careers sessions looking at the day to day role of the Police.</p> <p>The Committee was advised that the Cabinet Member for Communities was writing to the Police to raise this issue and there was agreement that an update should be provided at the next meeting.</p> <p><u>Tottenham Green – Park Cleanliness</u> The Council's Neighbourhood Action Team had advised that they had reviewed the cleansing schedule for the area and that there had been an improvement in the level of litter there.
