- 20mph Vehicle Activated Signs (VAS) installed on Hornsey Lane
  - Bell bollard (half) installed at the junction of Whitehall Road and Hornsey Lane
  - Road markings refreshed along Hornsey Lane in the vicinity of the school
  - Bus stop relocated from outside the school on Hornsey Lane to Stanhope Road
- 5.5 This proposal was identified as part of the planning agreement for Whitehall Park School, to improve road safety on Hornsey Lane in the vicinity of the school.

## 6 Proposals

- 6.1 The Hornsey Lane proposal consists of the replacement of two existing speed cushions with sinusoidal humps to reduce traffic speeds and improve the highway environment.

## 7 Consultation

- 7.1 Local Ward Councillors were informed of the proposals on the 8<sup>th</sup> June 2018. Only one response received in support of the proposal.
- 7.2 Public consultation was conducted between 19<sup>th</sup> June and 10<sup>th</sup> July 2018, the consultation document is shown in Appendix A.
- 7.3 If a decision is taken to proceed to implementation, Statutory Notification of the proposed speed humps will need to be undertaken.

## 8 Responses to Consultation

- 8.1 A total of 2 responses were received. Of those 2 responses, 1 was in favour and 1 objected

10.3.1 These proposals will improve road safety for all road users. The consultation documents were distributed to all households / businesses within the agreed consultation area and also placed on the Councils web-site to ensure that all stakeholders were made aware of the Councils proposals.

## Statutory Notification

### Hornsey Lane: Proposed Speed Humps

Dear Resident or Business,

As part of the Whitehall Park School development, we have received some funding to provide road safety improvements on Hornsey Lane. We are proposing to utilise this funding to replace the existing speed cushions with sinusoidal humps to tackle the speeding issues. Details are set out on the attached plan.

This proposal will compliment improvement measures that have already been carried out in the vicinity of the school, which are listed below:

- 20mph Vehicle Activated Signs (VAS) installed on Hornsey Lane
- Bell bollard (half) installed at the junction of Whitehall Road and Hornsey Lane
- Road markings refreshed along Hornsey Lane in the Vicinity of the school
- Bus stop relocated from outside the school on Hornsey Lane to Stanhope Road

We have also instructed the contractor to improve the lighting and upgrade the Belisha beacons with lit poles, these works will be completed in the coming weeks.

This notification letter marks the start of a three week period during which we welcome your comments.

Please ensure that your comments reach us by 10 July 2018. Your feedback will enable us to decide whether we should go ahead with the proposal as planned, or if changes are required.
