# 9. Staffing Issues related to Child Protection

- 9.1 A secondment was made of a Deputy Director and a Senior Team Manager from another London council during the week beginning 17<sup>th</sup> November 2008 to address child protection issues. The immediate focus was to conduct continuing assessments of the current safety of child protection and children in need assessment and decision-making processes. This work now continues under the direction of the Director of Children's Services who has been appointed by the Secretary of State on the 1<sup>st</sup> December who also confirmed the position of the Deputy Director.
- 9.2 The current position is that the Directorate is working hard with the support and flexibility of staff and managers to ensure as far as possible the robustness of current and in-coming referrals and review more recent cases where there is evidence of potential weakness. The situation is critical and is being managed and assessed daily.
- 9.3 An initial assessment has been made for additional management and senior capacity both to cover vacancies and to reinforce quality. This assessment is as follows but may be subject to change:
  - 3 Service Managers (2 for fieldwork, one for adoption and fostering)
  - 1 Senior Team Managers
  - 4 Team Managers.
- 9.4 Qualified social workers will continue to be needed and we need to be aware of the possibility that existing staff may leave or need other support.
- 9.5 Capital Ambition whose role is to support and improve performance across London are working in conjunction with the Association of London Directors of Children Services in sourcing the personnel outlined above. In addition, the Deputy Director is dealing directly with the agencies. Financial support will be forthcoming from Capital Ambition in the first instance and the Chief Financial Officer is looking at the long term recruitment implications for the Authority.

# Individual Employment Issues

- 9.6 You are aware that the Director, Deputy Director and Senior Team Manager were suspended on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2008 and currently are being dealt with as speedily as possible in line with employment law and contractual obligations. The Director was summarily dismissed on 8<sup>th</sup> December 2008 in accordance with part 4K of the Council Constitution.
- 9.7 The current position for the three social workers is that they are not working in child protection whilst a review of actions to date takes

place.

9.8 The Directions from the Secretary of State, direct the appointed Director of Children's Services to address staffing matters and this is happening and ongoing.

# Safeguarding Board and SCR Panel

9.9 Mr Graham Badman has been appointed as Chair of the Local Children's Safeguarding Board (LCSB) and as stated in the directions he will review the Serious Case Review of Baby P. He has commenced this work.

#### Action Plan for JAR Recommendations

9.10 The work to scope the action plan for JAR recommendations has begun. The Deputy Director Business Support and Development is the CYPS Lead and the Director for Special Projects has joined the CYPS team to ensure an integrated approach across the Council. A project management approach has been adopted. This recognises that the action plan for the review requires a major change programme so that the theme of 'safeguarding being everyone business' is clear.
