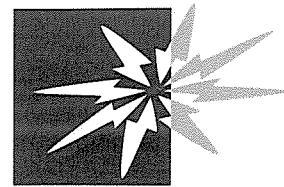

I would like to confirm that I have considered the above proposal with regard to the prevention of public nuisance on behalf of the Enforcement Response (Noise) Team & would like to make representations to the Variation.

on the following grounds

The operating schedule does not address the prevention of public nuisance from:

- A - airborne entertainment noise
- B - Structure borne noise or vibrations from entertainment
- C - Noise generated by patrons in external areas of the premises e.g. beer garden
- D - Noise generated from patrons queuing to enter
- E - Noise from patrons exiting the premises

Having visited the premises and spoken to the management concerning noise issues that may be generated by the extended hours and entertainment (Recorded music only), please find my recommendations below for recommended conditions below.

Prevention of nuisance from noise/vibration

Airborne

All doors and windows will remain closed during the regulated entertainment activities. Doors used for patrons to enter or leave the premises will be fitted with self-closing devices and staff told to ensure that they are not propped open. A member of staff shall be required to ensure doors are opened for as brief a period as possible

The licensable activity shall conclude a minimum 30 minutes before the premises is due to close to prevent excessive noise breakout as the premises empties

Entrance/exit from the premises whilst regulated entertainment activities are ongoing shall be via a lobbied door to minimise noise breakout

Structure borne

All speakers are mounted on anti-vibration mountings to prevent vibration transmission of sound energy to adjoining properties

Prevention of nuisance from litter

Adequate receptacles for use by patrons will be provided in the local vicinity. The positioning of the receptacles will be agreed with the licensing officer

Prevention of Nuisance from Odour

All ventilation and extraction systems shall be correctly maintained and regularly serviced to ensure that it is operating efficiently and with minimal disturbance to neighbours arising from odour

Prevention of nuisance from light

Illuminated external signage shall be switched off when the premises is closed

Security lights or flood lights will be positioned to minimise light intrusion to nearby residential premises

police team have made alcohol seizures
and fixed penalty notices have been issued for
breaching the condition to cease drinking and
disorderly conduct. It is a fact that licensed
premises do not always respect their legal and
social responsibilities.

I appeal to you further reasons for not
extending

- a) The road is situated between two ~~residential~~
residential roads and has no parking facilities
of its own, therefore cars will be parked
up to 3/4 in the morning people high on
drink or leaving banging doors and other
anti social habits, making it impossible for
residents to sleep.
- b) The pub is situated very close to a
infants school and two nurseries.
- c) The doors and windows of the pub will be
open with loud music blowing out making
it impossible to use your garden or back
of house.

It is a known fact that men in Hong Kong are more likely to die from alcohol related illness than any other area of London, however I have no doubt that a licence will be granted therefore.

1) Air conditioning and sound proofing must be installed.

2) CCTV cameras.

3) People must not drink outside the pub.

4) Notices must be displayed stating that they are in a residential area and must depart in a quiet manner.

5) Premises must be inspected on a regular basis re drugs, alcohol abuse, antisocial behaviour, prostitution and vice.



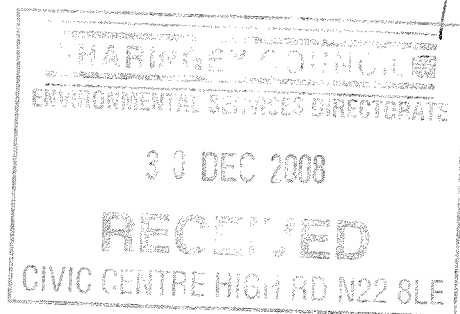

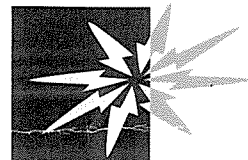

Re The Moll Cutpurse, Tottenham High Road.

We are long term residents (35 years) at 16 Wargrave Avenue, N15.

Up to now the above establishment has been very respectable and causes no problem whatsoever. However, we feel that if it were to extend its hours, this would add to the social problems which have been building up over the last 2-3 years, viz:

the opening of 2 off licenses at the High Road end of Wargrave Avenue, one of which is open from 7am until 2am the following day, i.e. 19 hours per day. During that time there is constant purchase of alcohol and drinking in the street, noisy exchanges in the early hours of the morning, cans being thrown everywhere, vomiting and urinating in public.

If the Moll Cutpurse was allowed to extend its hours there would be more drunkard behaviour, more disturbance late at night, and the above social problems would be intensified. In addition, Wargrave Avenue has a problem with parking. As well as the social meeting places, there is also the UKCG meeting place which is very active and it would be even more impossible to park anywhere near one's house.

Since there is no public transport in the early hours of the morning (0100 - 0200) users of the public house would have to use their own cars and they would probably too intoxicated to legally drive. This could lead to damage to other vehicles and worse.

We are not against people having social niceties of life, but would ask you to consider the right of the residents of the road to have a quieter and less disturbed environment.

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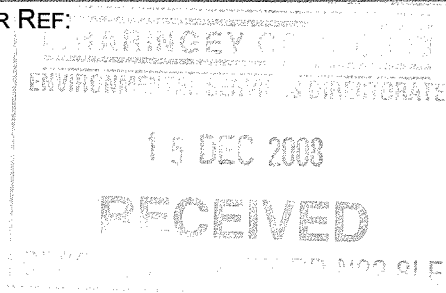
