1. Purpose of the report (That is, the decision required)

1.1 To inform the Committee of a variation in the mix of units built on the site and to request approval to vary the Section 106 Agreement attached to the planning permission for the erection of 2×4 storey blocks and 1×2 storey block comprising 5 commercial units on the ground floor; 4×3 bed houses, 12×1 bed and 14×2 bed flats; 30 units in total to accord with the built mix.
