It is unbelievable that the council's planners agreed to the installation of this unsightly equipment within the curtilage of a listed building. When granting permission for this, Spurs latest development please make it a condition the equipment is removed. If it needs to be reinstated elsewhere, there is plenty of kerbside space in front of the stadium where a row of heritage buildings has been demolished.	The monitoring unit has been installed on a temporary basis in accordance with the approved Stadium Development Air Quality Monitoring Plan (November 2018).
