6.1 The Panorama room was erected in 2000 to provide additional space for events. It remains a popular facility providing a flexible space which accommodates events which

- are too small for the larger halls and provides ancillary space to service the larger events.
- 6.2 The existing planning permission reference HGY/2000/1446 for a marquee on the site of the SW wing (the panorama room) has, as condition One, a clause requiring the removal of the marquee in April 2006.
- 6.3 This application seeks to vary condition one of the existing planning permission and associated listed building consent to effectively extend the permission for the existing marquee structure for a further five years from April 2006 to April 2011.
