### 4.Background information

- 4.1 On the 1 of December John Jones was appointed on an interim basis to the role of Head of Legal and Governance. This was dealt with in accordance with paragraph 6 of the employment procedure rules set out in the Constitution at Part 4 Section K.
- 4.2 On the 29<sup>th</sup> of January, following a recruitment process in line with employment procedure rules set out in the constitution at part 4 Section K, Fiona Alderman was appointed to the role of Head of Legal and Governance.
- 4.3 The 1989 Local Government and Housing Act imposes a duty on the authority to designate one of their officers (to be known as the Monitoring Officer) as the officer responsible for performing the duties imposed under section 5 of the Act. The duties imposed on the authority's Monitoring officer under this Act shall be performed by him personally or, where he/she is unable to act owing to absence or illness, personally by such member of his staff as he has for the time being nominated as his deputy for the purposes of this section.

The role of Head of Legal and Governance is also designated as the Councils Monitoring Officer.

- 4.4 Article 11.01c of the Constitution advises that the Council has to appoint officers to fulfil the statutory roles identified in Part 3, Section E, Section 3.
- 4.5 The recommendations meet the requirements of the 1989 Local Government and Housing Act and the Councils Contitutional provisions.
