

Proposal to Rename Albert Road Recreation Ground Consultation Overview – November 2020

- 730 responses received via online survey
- 370 (50.7%) respondents support changing the name of Albert Road Rec whilst 360 (49.3%) were opposed to this

Age

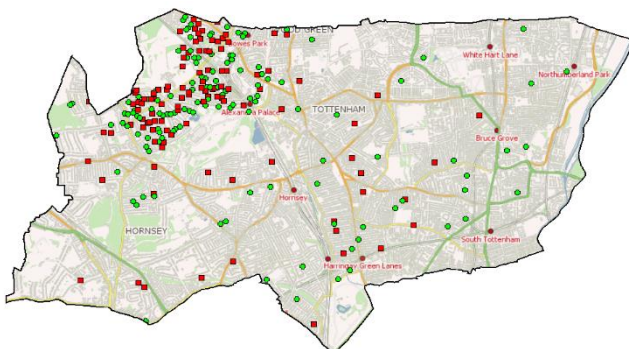
- The highest proportion of respondents are between the ages of 45-60 (37.5%) with 58.7% of this age group supporting renaming the Rec
- 16-24 year olds made up 2% of the respondent with almost all of them supporting the name change, 25-44 year old made up 21% of the vote and 61% of this age group supported the name change, over 65s also made up 21% of the respondents with 53% supporting changing the name
- Those who preferred not to state their age or left this blank accounted for 18% of respondents but 85% of these opposed changing the name of the rec

Ethnicity

- The largest ethnic group to respond were people who described their ethnicity as white which accounted for 530 respondents or 73% - 294 (55%) of this group supported changing the name of Albert Road Rec
- Asian and Asian British accounted for 4% of respondent, with 81% of these supported changing the name of the park
- Black and Black British made up 3% of respondents with 65% of this group supporting the name change
- 5% of people described themselves as mixed or multiple ethnic backgrounds of which 47% agree with changing the name
- 9% of respondents did not state their ethnicity and 81% of these opposed the name change
- Respondents who stated their ethnicity as 'other ethnic background made up 6% of respondents, with 84% of these wanting the name of Albert Road Recreation Ground to remain

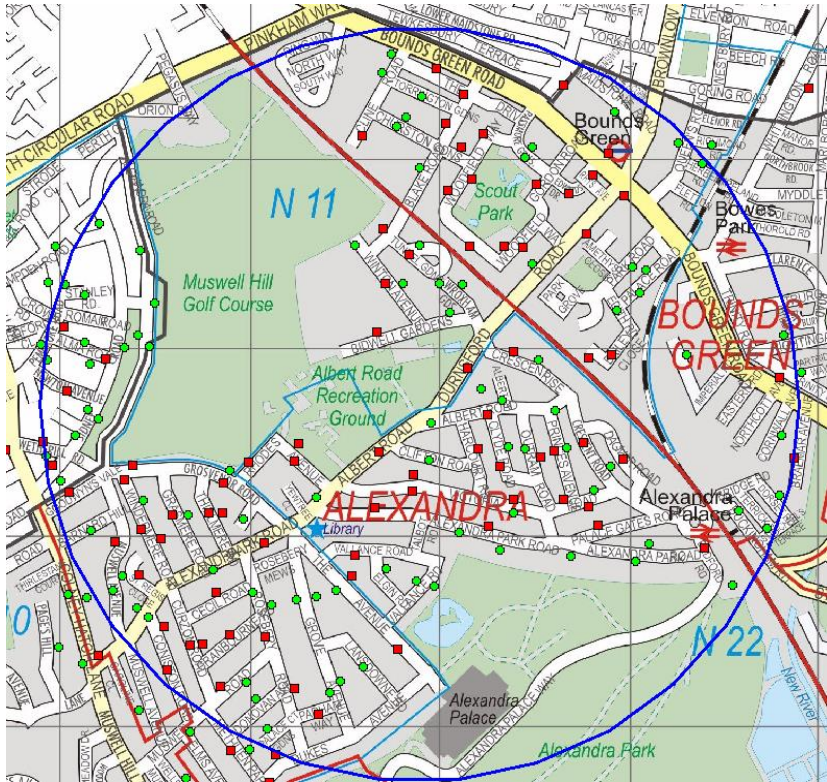
Response by location
