We already suffer from urinating in the corners behind this property. Noisy and disturbing groups enter neighbouring streets leaving litter, banging car doors. This will only increase with 3am opening, Car Parking Restrictions finish @ 22.00.

Public Safety

The pavement in front of the property has been used as parking and there are no kerbs or barriers to stop this. The council seems unable to respond.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

The site is immediately adjacent to a conservation area. A ban on street alcohol is in effect but the number of empty alcohol bottles and cans every morning in Aldershoe, Redvers and Moselle Ave indicate that this is already out of control. Adding extra cannot be good.

The Protection of Children from Harm

Residential Housing is above and beside this location and any children in them will suffer from disturbance. The current cafe closes @ 21.00 which reduces the problem.

The Prevention of Crime and Disorder TACO BELL is inches from a Conservation Area, where this is an alcohol control zone. I do not believe that this is enforced. Empty spirit bottles and beer cans are littered on Gladstone Avenue already. Illegal parking will take place. Noel Park restrictions end at 22:00. Littering is a crime. I believe there will be breaches of the Peace in a Conservation Area.

Public Safety Illegal Pavement leisure parking already takes place on this site. This is an offence under Section 137 & 148 of the HIGHWAYS Act 1980. See Haringey Complaint Ref LBH 10767521. Patrons will Pavement park causing a noise. No CEO's will be on duty. This is already dangerous. There is no kerb.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance Fouling and LITTERING and NOISE. Patrons will smoke outside and drop their litter. Mobile phone conversations will be noisy. Car doors closing and mopeds revving the engines will be noisy. The adjacent Buller Rd N22 is already a "toilet". Street Urinating will increase. Street alcohol consumption will increase in Noel Park.

The Protection of Children from Harm There are residential homes currently being constructed above TACO BELL. There is a Human Right to protect your right to enjoy your property peacefully. Protocol 1, Article 1. Noise and disturbances at 03:00 are proven to affect the health and wellbeing of children thus affecting a child's development.
