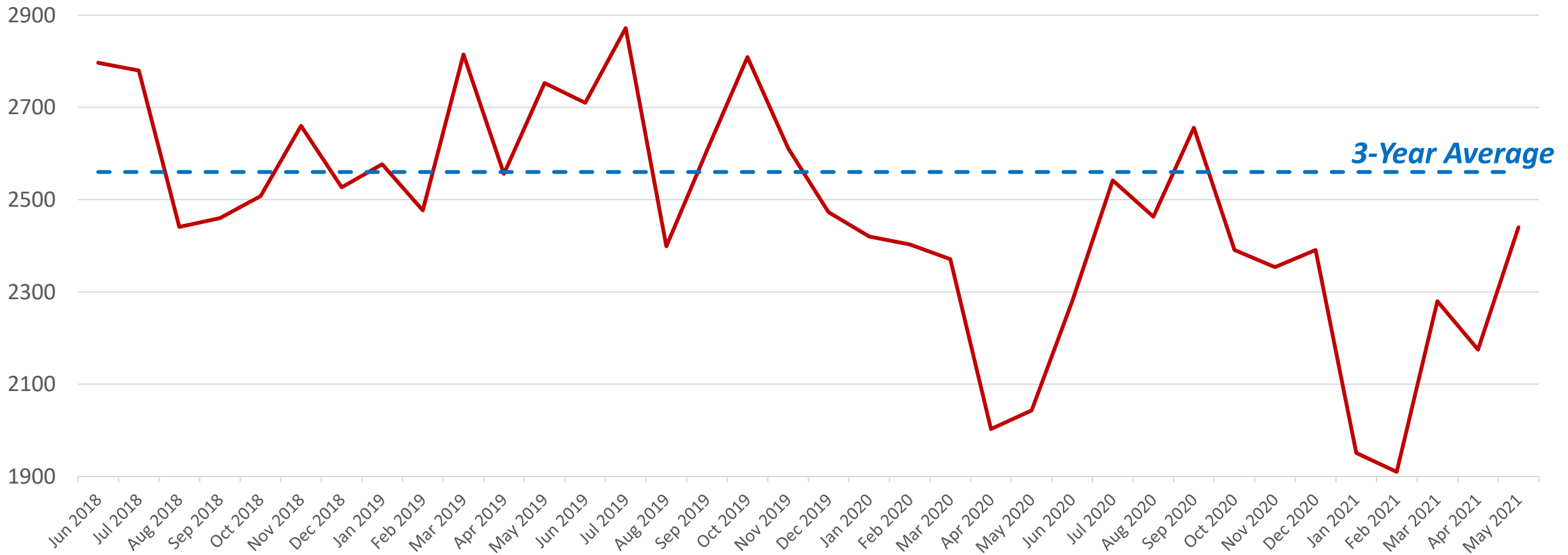

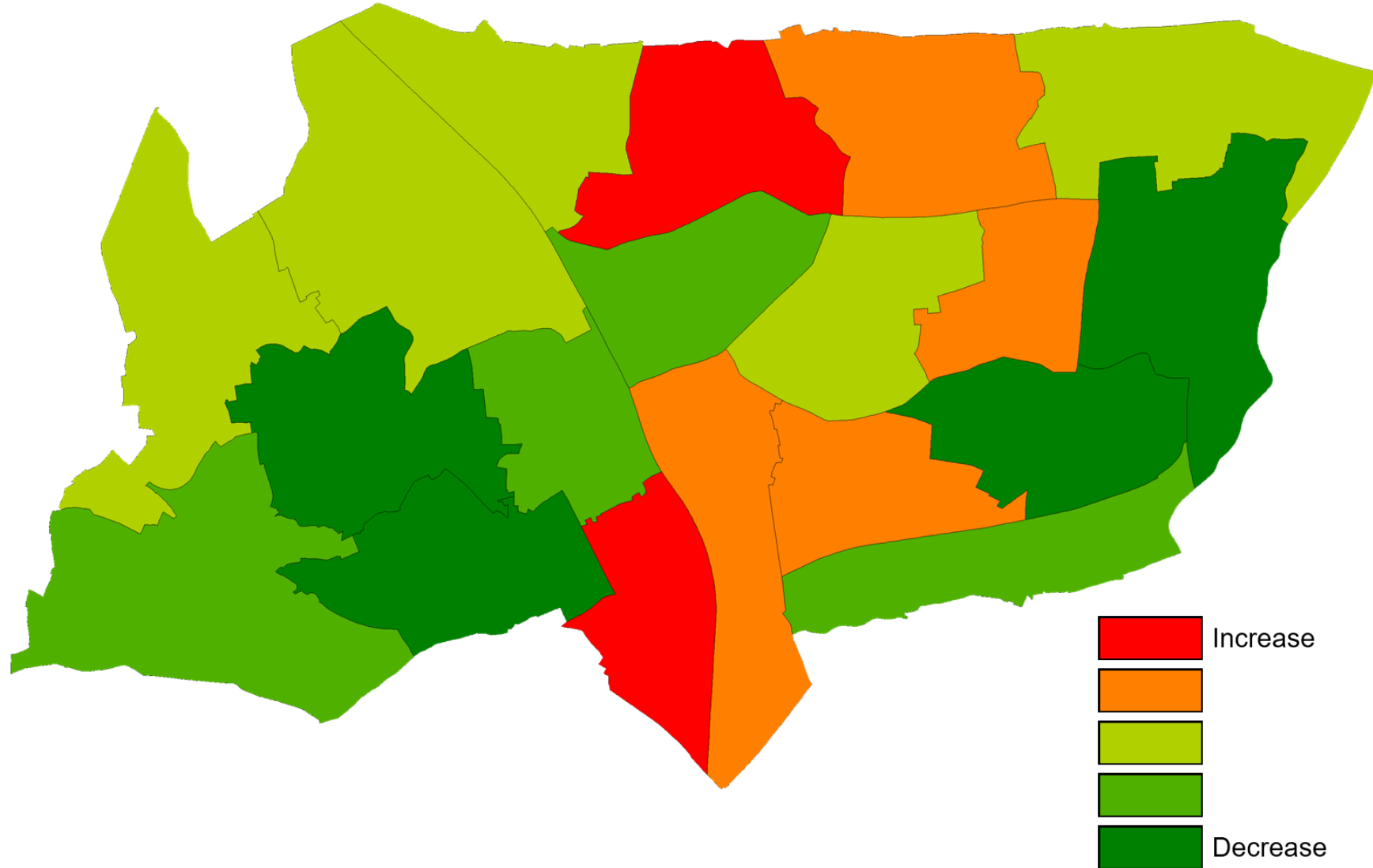

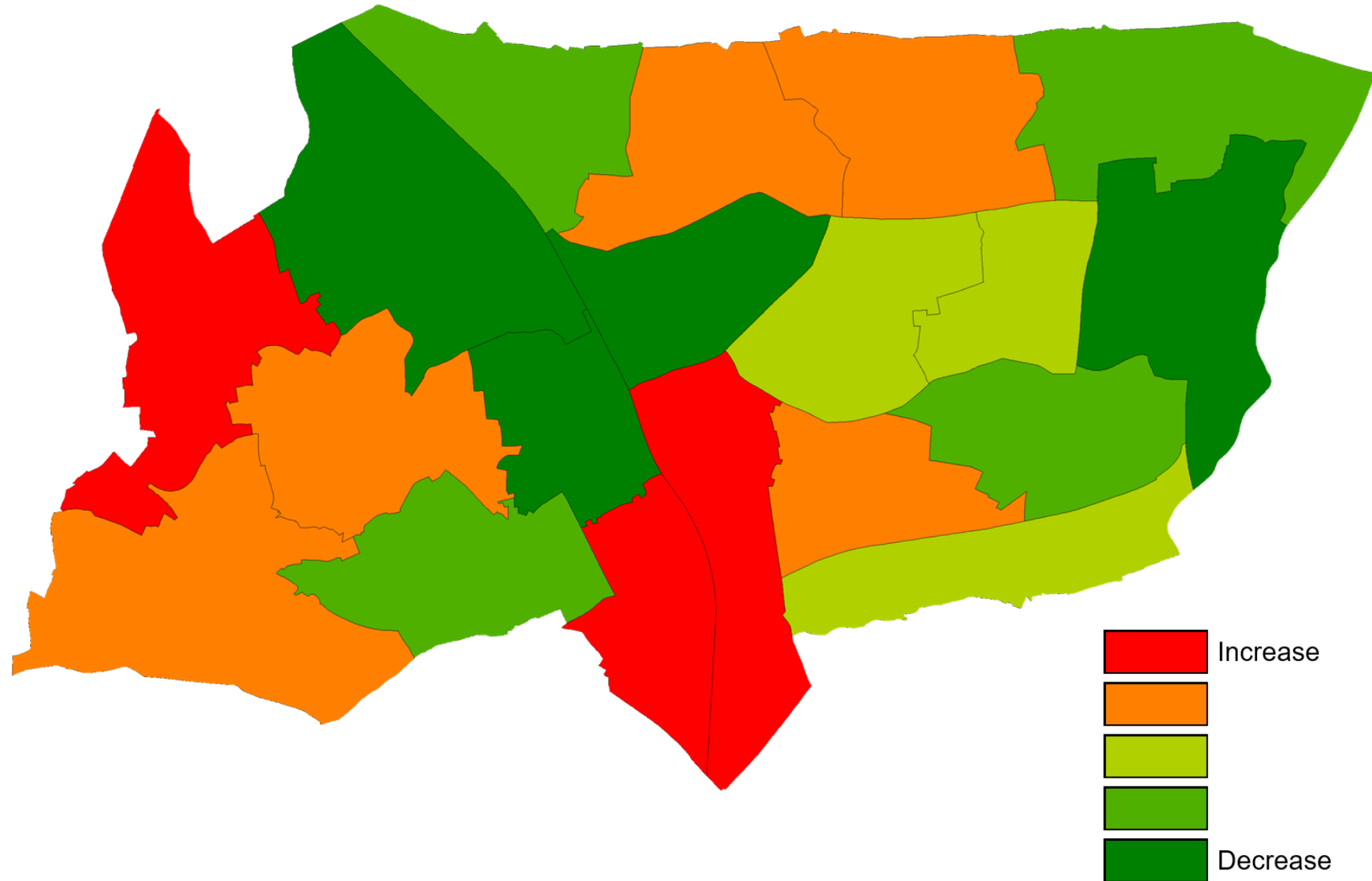
# Violence with Injury (Non Domestic Abuse)

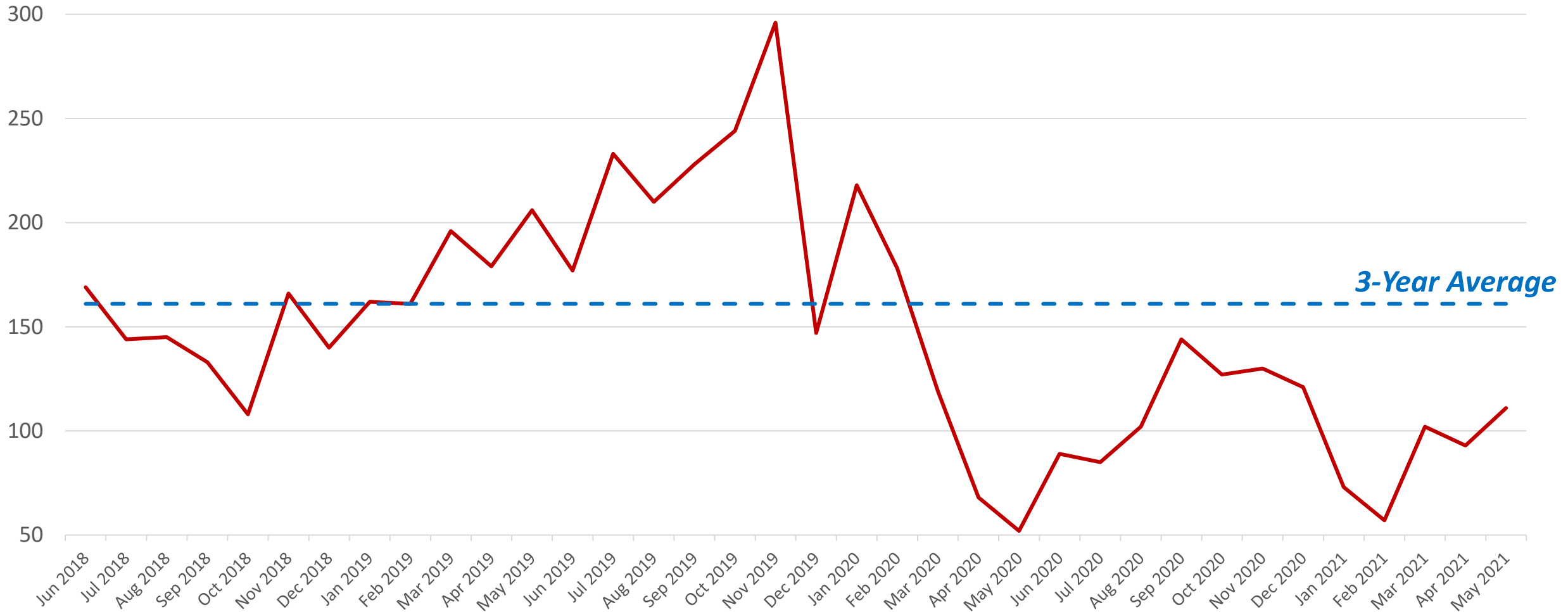

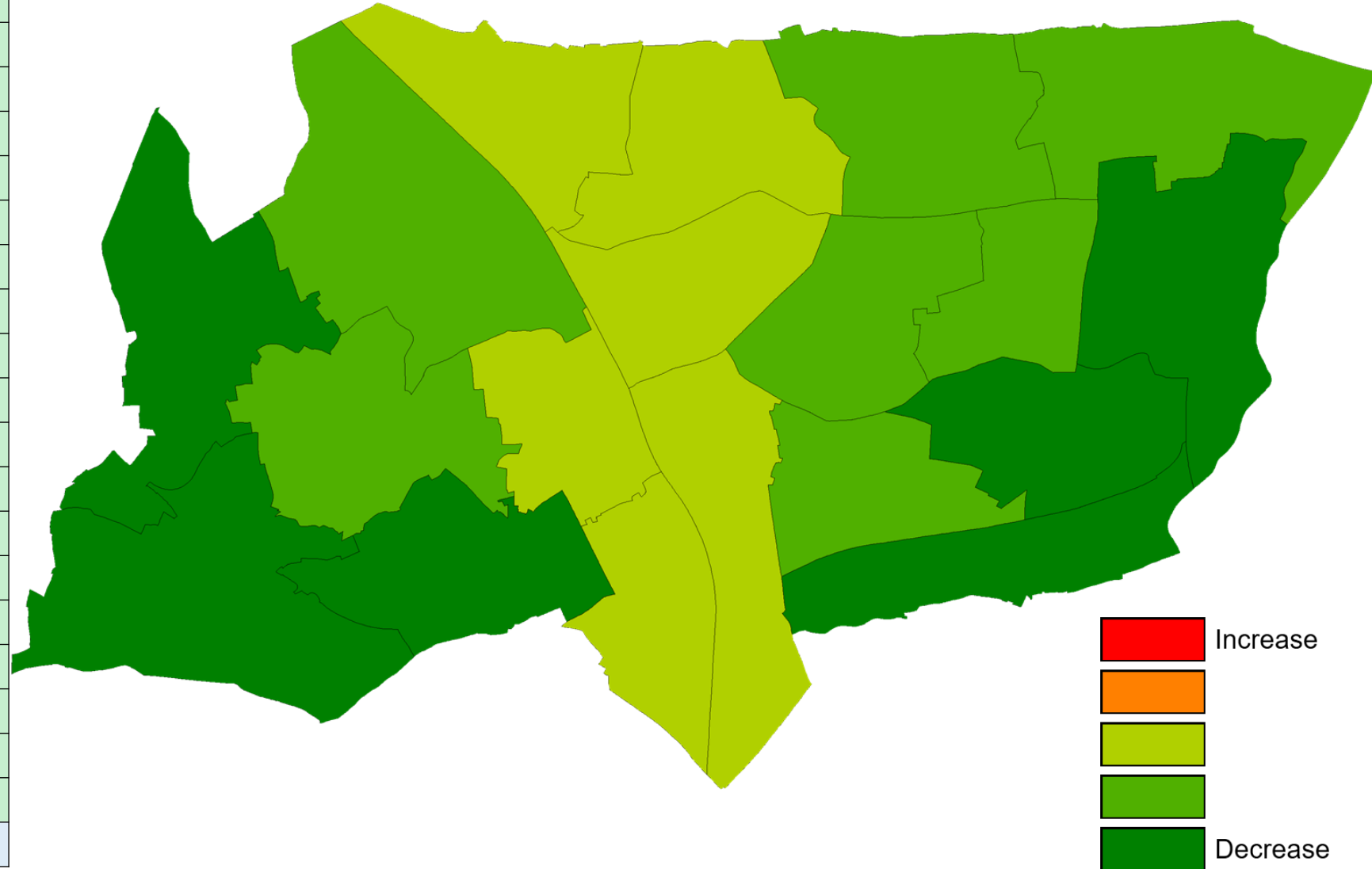

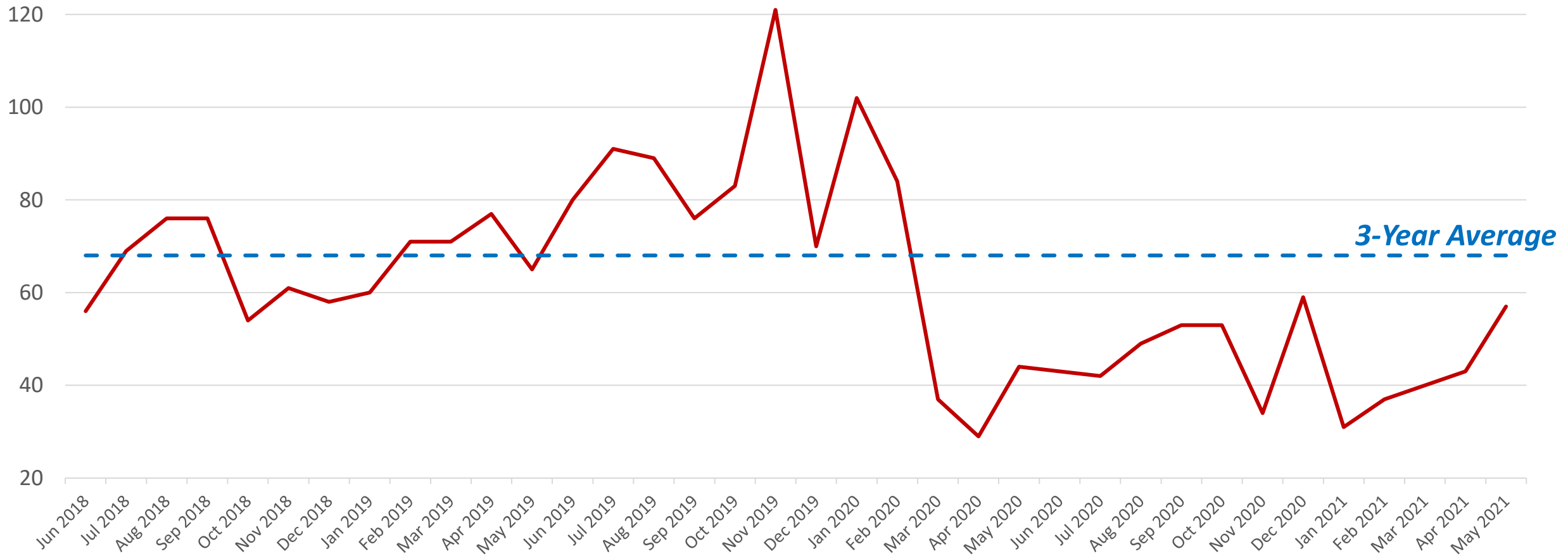
