Furthermore, I would suggest that it is incumbent upon the Council to make sure that a design which has been agreed safe for a Licence to be issued, is what has actually been built.

Therefore this office reaffirms the Representation, on the grounds of Public Safety, for this Application for the following matters;

- 1. Details of fireproof rating of all furnishings to be provided.
- 2. Details of floor coverings and underlays to be provided to show compliance with British Standard BS5438-1989 and tested to BS 4790 or Class 0.
- 3. Details to be provided to demonstrate that all fabrics, curtains, drapes and similar features in the main areas are either be non-combustible or be of durably or inherently flame retardant fabric.
- 4. Details of Input or output ventilation to be provided.
- 5. Heating provision details to be been submitted.
- 6. Details of the electrical installation including cabling type and protection to be provided.
- 7. Management lighting details to be been provided.
- 8. Insufficient sanitary accommodation shown for the ground floor area. The requirement from the Technical Standards for Places of Entertainments requires a minimum for 1600 people is as follows;
  - 33 female WC, 7 male WC, 16 Urinals, 33 female wash hand basins, 9 male wash
  - hand basins, Disposal units for sanitary dressing in each female wc cubicle. At
  - least one bucket/cleaner's sink not shown per block of toilets
- 9. The proposed fully automatic fire alarm system is not appropriate for entertainment premises. A 2 stage system should be provided to such a premises allowing for a controlled evacuation, if necessary, by the management.
