Dear Sir/ Madam,

We understand that the above Public House has applied for a late alcohol licence 7 days per week. We live next door to this premises, (**Sector 1997**, Highgate High St, N6 5JJ) and since its reopening last Summer under new ownership, we have already experienced repeated noise, including them playing very loud music beyond 11pm on weekends, as well as their patrons creating extensive noise. The patrons stand outside of the pub, on Highgate High Street smoking, laughing, shouting and generally making a nuisance of themselves. Mostly at the weekend and well past a reasonable time when we want to go to bed. My daughters bedroom faces onto the High Street and more often than not she is unable to sleep because of the noise coming from the pub. Our bedroom is at the rear of the High Street and we also can hear the noise from this premises very clearly. We have in fact complained to the environmental health team at Haringey council on at least

clearly. We have in fact complained to the environmental health team at Haringey council on at least 5 occasions since last Summer, when the noise has been intolerable between 11.30pm and 1.30am. We trust these complaints have been logged, as we have spoken to the enforcement officers including Steve Davis several weeks ago.

When lodging complaints with Haringey council we have been told on many occasions that Jenny Barrett, Head of Noise Control would be addressing our complaints and would contact us directly, however, she has never had the courtesy to do this thus far.

We absolutely object to this pub being granted any ability to remain open beyond regular opening hours i.e. 11pm. They show no regard for their neighbours and for the wider residents of the village. It is clear that the patrons are not locals and also have no regard for residents and the wider community.

We are a quiet, family oriented village which does not want to attract late party revellers, together with all the rubbish, noise and extra traffic they attract.

I very strongly object to any extension of the hours of opening of the Dukes Head, in particular beyond 1130.

I live at Bisham Gardens and am already kept away by the noise of revellers, especially on the street, whenever I go to bed early, in other words before 1030 pm.

Many of these revellers currently park in Bisham Gardens and once they have finished partying on the street many come down this road to collect their cars, often the worse for drink, and cause further disturbance. Few of the customers appear to live locally.

At present the noise is just about acceptable but if the application is approved it will not be. In a residential area I don't think it reasonable for a pub to be tipping out its customers in the early hours of the morning.
