3. EXTENSION OF CYCLEWAY 1 (C1) ROUTE TO QUEEN STREET VIA WHITE HART LANE

The Cabinet Member for Environment, Transport and the Climate Emergency considered the report which reported on the feedback of statutory consultation carried out from 20 October to 12 November 2021, on the proposal to extend the current Cycleway 1 (C1) Route to Queen Street via White Hart Lane. The report also sought approval to proceed to implementation, having considered objections received to the statutory consultation.

The Cabinet Member RESOLVED

To approve the implementation of the proposed improvements to Cycleway C1 – Queen Street which includes:

- (a) The extension of Cycleway 1 (C1) Route to Queen Street via White Hart Lane as detailed in Appendix (I); and
- (b) The installation of the proposed modal filter in White Hart Lane at its junction with Queen Street.

Reasons for decision

The Council is required to consider the feedback received during the statutory notification period, in particular any objections to proposals, prior to proceeding to implementation. The proposals consulted upon are aimed at providing safe conditions for cyclists using the CS1 route but will also benefit pedestrians.
