Reflection on Q1 and Q2 2008 data	The data Q1 (52.1 per 1000 with 45 actual conceptions) and Q2 (57.2 per 1000 with 49 actual conceptions), shows good progress for Haringey - Q2 showed a decrease of 23.8 from Q2 07 which was 81.0per 1000 which is significantly better than the London regional rate which showed a 2.00 per cent decrease from the Q2 07 rate. Our rolling quarterly average is now down to 61.2 per 1000 which is first time we have a achieved a quarterly average rate lower than our 1988 base rate of 62.7 and the first time that we have achieved two consecutive rates in the 50s. Our Q2 rates have consistently shown a significant increase from Q1 but the Q2 data shows there has been a small increase from Q1 08.
