The hours we plan to serve alcohol are Mon – Sat – 12:00 – 22:30 / Sunday & Bank Holidays 12:00 – 22:00 as agreed with the local authority. As you are aware there are other already licenced premises that are open longer hours so I feel it is unfair to say that we would make any existing problems worse.

I am happy to uphold all objectives and conditions outlined by the local authority and would love to see the public nuisance in the area come to an end. ‘
