Apologies for the delay on this.

1. Are you able to confirm you are happy with the standard of our operation across the five events last year (including in particular the security operation, and the measures taken to prevent crime and disorder), and it is on that basis that you have not lodged a representation against the licence applications for an increase in capacity and addition of an extra day for 2024, because you expect us to manage the events in 2024 to a similar standard?

The MPS has carefully considered your application and in doing so reviewed the past shows Karankbrother have produced. Following this review we do not consider that we need to place any further representations beyond those already agreed on your existing licence. Should the committee be minded to grant your application we will continue to work with you to make sure the events run smoothly and as crime free as possible.

Are you able to confirm the recorded crime figures across our events in 2023, which we understand to have been a total of 16 reported thefts (predominantly of phones) within the site perimeter, and one robbery that occurred outside the site perimeter? Can you confirm this level of offending is commensurate with what you

would expect in the area over the same period, even if our events had not taken place?

Clearly the presence of a large music event in the park does create a crime footprint however as described above the offences recorded are commensurate with like or similar events of this nature. The 16 recorded thefts whilst regrettable for the victims concerned I would consider the number to be low considering the footprint and numbers attending your shows.

Hi Dale

I have interrogated our crime reporting system searching for crime recorded in the period s that the Krankbrother concerts were on in 2023. Filtering out allegations that were nothing to do with the shows I can find 16 allegations of theft. All of these are mobile phones allegedly stolen while patrons were dancing within the confines of the event space.

There was also one recorded bomb threat where a disgruntled customer phoned in threatening to blow the concert up.

One person was robbed by it appears local youths as they left the venue near to the tennis courts.

So we average approximately 3 allegations of theft per show.

Theft -16Robbery -1

There were two allegations of sexual offences during the period concerned however these were not concert related.
