PROPOSED REMOVAL OF PARKING BAYS AND INTRODUCTION OF NO WAITING AT ANY TIME RESTRICTIONS ON THE BANK N6

The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No.*) Order 202***

The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Order 202***

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey proposes to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 35, 45, 46 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The general effect of the Orders would be:

- 1) To replace the existing Resident Permit Holder only bays on the north side of The Bank N6 west of the Channing School access gates with new Double Yellow Line restrictions.
- 2) To formalise the existing Double Yellow Line restrictions by revoking the Business Permit Holder Only bays on the north side of The Bank N6 between the junction with Cholmeley Park, east to the existing Resident Permit Holder Only bays west of the Channing School access gates. This is an administrative change to ensure accuracy of our map-based records which will result in no physical changes on site.
