| Reasons for the decision   | The business will use the loan to increase its workspace and purchase new machinery and equipment. The proposed expansion of the business will take place in two phases. The first phase will involve creation of a mezzanine floor to move the current offices and storage facilities to the mezzanine floor making room for new production machinery and a blast freezer and undertaking the necessary infrastructure and building works to increase production and introduce new products.  |

It will protect and enhance the commercial viability of these industrial areas by providing affordable loans for premises' refurbishment and |

# **Exempt Information**

#### Local Government Act 1972 Schedule 12A

## Part 1: Descriptions of Exempt Information

- 1. Information relating to any individual.
- 2. Information which is likely to reveal the identity of an individual.
- 3. Information relating to the financial or business affairs of any person (including the authority holding that information).
- 4. Information relating to any consultations or negotiations or contemplated consultations or negotiations in connection with any labour relations matter arising between the authority or a Minister of the Crown and employees of, or office holders under, the authority.
- 5. Information in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings.
- 6. Information which reveals that the authority proposes -
  - (a) To give under any enactment a notice under or by virtue of which requirements are imposed on a person; or
  - (b) To make an order or direction under any enactment.
- 7. Information relating to any action taken or to be taken in connection with the prevention, investigation or prosecution of crime.

Note: It is insufficient to simply identify a category of exemption, you must also conduct a public interest test on the basis specified in the Act as follows:

Information falling within categories 1-7 is exempt if and so long as in all the circumstances of the case the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.

### **Confidential Decisions**

- The decision contains information provided by a Government department on a non disclosure basis
- 2. There is a Court order against disclosure.
