Decision	For the Head of Programme Management – Regeneration and Economic Development to approve the contract award and implementation under Contract Standing Order (CSO) 8.02 for delivery of the Podcast and community radio project. The contract is for the sum of £9,999.
Reasons for the decision	<p>The Estate Regeneration Fund aims to cultivate a strong and healthy community, with a focus on building positive activities for young people. This also aligns with the Council's ambition outlined in the Corporate Delivery Plan (2023/24) under the theme for Children and Young People, aiming to 'Enable community collaboration and develop youth voices.'</p> <p>The Podcast and community radio project directly addresses this objective by providing skills development and opportunities for young people to contribute to community dialogue, share their perspectives, and shape the narrative of their neighbourhoods. By curating diverse content such as local news, events, interviews, and discussions, the project aims to resonate with the community. Furthermore, it explores collaborative opportunities with local organisations, schools, businesses, and individuals to broaden its reach. Ultimately, the Podcast and community radio project aspire to amplify community voices, foster dialogue, and promote civic engagement and empowerment within the neighbourhoods.</p> <p>This work is wholly funded from the Estate Regeneration Fund budget allocation.</p>
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected by the officer when making the decision	<p>The following options were considered:</p> <p>Option 1: 'Do Nothing' - This would limit the council's ability to work with and empower local communities, particularly young people and those young people that are Not in Education or Training (NEETs), to become invested in their area and connected with each other through cultural activities, which is a key objective of the Estate Regeneration Fund and Corporate delivery Plan (2023/24).</p>
