Hi Haringey Council,

I am a resident at 69 Hillfield Avenue.

I disagree on another disabled bay on Hillfield Avenue for a number of reasons:

1. There is a disabled bay outside 75 Hillfield avenue, which is only 4 doors down and roughly 7 meters away from the proposed new Disabled bay. As all houses/flats have steps, I do not see why access to the next disabled bay (no additional vertical steps) would prevent a disabled person who is already tackling steps in and out their home to use that one instead of a new one.
2. The current Disabled spot is never used by a disabled person, therefore why do we need 2 spots so close together? 5
3. We have limited parking already, with the knowledge of points 2 and 3 it seems we are not creating a bay for a person with a disability (as there is one) but removing a normal parking bay when already low on supply.

None of the residents of 37 North View Road have walking impairments. It should not therefore be provided. In addition, parking spaces are already limited in North View Road, and there are elderly residents in the road who do not have disabled parking bays and who may benefit from them.

I recently had a communication through the letterbox outlining that you intend on putting a Disabled Bay in front of 37 North View Road. I'm afraid I will need to contest this on the basis that number 37 is currently for sale. A review of the new owners/occupiers and whether they meet the criteria will need to be conducted after the sale.

In addition, can you please outline why you have removed pavement parking on Nightingale Lane? I note that one of the reasons on your website is that it reduces the space pedestrians have. Again, I will need to contest this on the basis that the pavements are now over four metres wide. You have reduced the width of the road leading to further congestion, already exacerbated by the (i) school street you installed, (ii) the parking restrictions you installed and (iii) the fact that waste services seem to take place at 8am as opposed to 6am pre pandemic.

Finally, in relation to the parking restrictions you have installed on every road around our road, it won't surprise you to know that residents of those roads are now parking in our street to avoid paying for a permit. It is impossible to park on our street now and I'd like to hear how you imagined you would combat that? I am sure you will have conducted trouble shooting/scenario planning as part of your expert planning? Please advise?

As far as I can see, the resident of No 37 has no mobility issues and nor does her son, who lives with her. She is young and able-bodied and I often see her out walking. For several months, she has been placing two bins in the road to "reserve" a parking space. One of these bins now has a notice saying the space is for a disabled person.

With residents' parking recently introduced on neighbouring roads, parking space on North View Road is very tight and if you come home late in the evening, it is almost impossible to find a parking place. These new disabled bays are also very large. If the resident at No. 37 had mobility issues, I would not lodge an objection, but she does not. I am sure there are some elderly residents in the road, or people with genuine mobility issues, who might welcome a disabled bay.
