We have cctv installed covering all critical areas inside and outside, in addition we provide regular training for staff on how to handle aggressive behaviour, identify fake ID's and deal with intoxicated people. We will also only be serving alcohol as part as a meal and to adults only and making sure we comply with challenge 25
- c) **Public safety**: Regular safety checks are conducted to ensure all safety equipment such as fire extinguishers and emergency exists are in working order and accessible, we adhere to the maximum occupancy limits to prevent over crowding and to prevent any safety risks we will also implement a refuasal book which will help identify any person to adhere to the public safety and prevent any nuisance or crime
- d) **The prevention of public nuisance**: We have a noise control device whixh prevents loud music and monitors noise levels, we also avoid advertising practices which promotes excessive drinking and more importantly we as a business engage in the community so that the communication channel with the local residents and business feel comfortable in addressing any concerns they may have regarding noise or disturbances
- e) The protection of children from harm: Staff will adhere to strict ID checking policy to prevent any underage drinking and sales. We are a family friendly business and kids seating will be allocated away from alcohol service points and all staff are vigilant about the presence of children and we make sure they wont be exposed to inappropriate behaviour or environments
