Road name	Support?	Comments
Willoughby Lane	Support	Absolutely essential that this crossing is put in place, currently there are no places for pedestrians to cross safely. I would suggest that more traffic calming measures should be put into place to help manage the unsustainable level of traffic on this road
Willoughby Lane	Support	In principle, we support this proposal as the road has become very dangerous with speeding vehicles and many pedestrians as you have identified.. However, we request that the length of the existing guardrail or a replacement is not extended in the direction of our premises. The reason for this is that we receive regular deliveries, and the impact would be to create a hazard, both in the road space itself and on the pavement area.. Many thanks for your attention to this.
Willoughby Lane	Support	The road traffic is noisy and although the speed limit is 20, they travel at 40 or more and it is difficult to cross the road. A speed monitoring camera would also be useful
Willoughby Lane	Support	Speed humps would slow down those who think that 20mph means 60mph for them.
Willoughby Lane	Support	we support this in principle. However, we request that the guard rail, or its replacement, is NOT EXTENDED IN THE DIRECTION OF OUR PREMISES. The reason for this is that we receive regular deliveries, and the railing would be a hazard as well as a pavement obstruction and making it difficult for our business. Thanks.
Willoughby Lane	Support	As both a mosque and a cultural centre, we have regular services attendees at our mosque - five times during a day. Therefore we fully support the project of the zebra crossing. We also believe that it will avoid the otherwise possible danger to people who regularly use this road.
Willoughby Lane	Object	The zebra crossing needs to be in between the 2 bus stops. So children can cross safely to go to power league. And both bus stops have a safe crossing. It makes no sense to stick it on the corner of the road no one is going to walk all the way up to cross over and walk all the way back down again especially a child. This road is so incredibly dangerous people speeding all day and night no regards for anyone at all. People park where they are not supposed to. I have had lorries crash into my wall and garden on a few occasions also. We need this road to be made as safe as can be as soon as possible.
