

I have noted the context of the 4 LICENSING OBJECTIVES:

Well unfortunately Number 2 of the objectives hasn't been met, as the noise team had to be called about loud music coming from 83, Mays Road, London N22 6UP. As the building extends into Coburg Road, the extension from the original building, which was the Duke of Edinburgh, as that's the very area that's been most problematic in regards to public nuisance, and the noise team had to be called on 23 occasions by myself and neighbours in Coburg Road. The Kameri family portrayed from the other people were there previously, well unfortunately they're no different to the others before them. Because of the public
