Officers were called to O/S Hornsey Tavern N8 for reports of two males fighting and one male has a Stanley knife and one has a huge knife. The descriptions provided on CAD 4567/24AUG24 was Turkish male, black jacket and short hair who was the one with a Stanley knife and the other was

	<p>wearing a red and white chequered top. CCTV had caught the incident on the local camera. Officers attended the location and no suspects were located initially after a few minutes and several MOP's were spoken to which no one had seen or heard what had happened. Plain clothes officers had then begun to leave the area as no suspects were located to which as they drove away from the scene they saw a male stood on the left hand side of the footpath on Campsbourne Road N8 and matched the description. Officers detained [REDACTED] under S1 PACE due to him matching the description and [REDACTED] immediately stated 'YES IT WAS ME' and aware of what had happened. CCTV had confirmed that [REDACTED] was the male in the black jacket and was the one fighting with the other male. The other suspect was not identified and CCTV confirmed that both [REDACTED] and SUS2 had been squaring up to each other and pushing each other and SUS2 had pulled a large knife from his waistband and begun to attempt to stab [REDACTED]. Due to this [REDACTED] had reached for his Stanley blade which was in his right jacket pocket in order to protect himself. A few seconds later [REDACTED] had then separated from the other male and ran off in attempt to get away from him in the general direction of Campsbourne Road N8. Officers could not locate the other suspect and unknown who he is and [REDACTED] stated the other male lives also in close proximity to him also in the [REDACTED] but unknown which door within the estate. No Stanley blade was located on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was intoxicated and was refusing to listen to officers and kept stating he wants his tools back as it was to do with a civil matter to do with tools. [REDACTED] stated the other male</p>

(2) Further Details.	<p>had a kitchen knife on him and [REDACTED] stated 'I had a carpet fitting knife on me' and made admissions to officers and stated he planted off the Stanley knife at his uncles house. Officers could not obtain an account from the other suspect involved and advised that [REDACTED] should go home. [REDACTED] refused to go home and due to the risk of him mentioning several times he wants his tools back and will not stop until he gets them back, the risk had to be removed and [REDACTED] was arrested for affray by PC Grainger as [REDACTED] knows the other suspect lives in the same postcode as him. [REDACTED] (WIT1) was spoken to and stated he saw the other suspect and [REDACTED] squaring up to each other whilst [REDACTED] was</p>

	on the road and shouting at each other and the other suspect was on the pavement and the other suspect jumped over the railing and approached [REDACTED] and continued shouting at him. Both then started to circle each other and [REDACTED] pulled his Stanley knife out of his right jacket pocket and extended it and kept it concealed but still in view of the other suspect. Another MOP intervened and [REDACTED] assumed that the MOP was going to diffuse the situation and then the other suspect had slid a knife from his sleeve and the MOP has taken the knife back off the other suspect and turned around and walked towards Turnpike Lane. [REDACTED] does not know what else happened and SUS2 had walked off with the other male. [REDACTED] was arrested and taken to Colindale Police station.
