	<p>6837/28FEB25, where it had been reported by [REDACTED] who is a bar assistant at the North Eight Public House, that there is approximately 50 people from the Irish Travelling Community fighting. At approximately 1958hrs, NA50L have arrived on scene with NA149L, NA103L and NA44L. Whilst officers entered the North Eight Public House, NA50L have remained outside, where they have located [REDACTED] and asked him to provide an initial account. [REDACTED] explained to officers that he was due to start his shift at North Eight Public House, when he has witnessed a fight occurring between a large crowd of IC1 males who he believed belonged to the Irish Travelling Community. [REDACTED] explained that one of the window had been smashed in the process and was unaware of any further damage as he didn't enter the pub. After ascertaining an account from [REDACTED], NA50L have entered the pub to assist in dispersing the Irish Travelling Community from the pub. After managing to disperse a majority of the Irish Travelling Community, PC DELLER has spoken to the North Eight Pub Landlord, James KEARNS, to ascertain an account from himself. KEARNS explained that two IC1 males had a fight, where a chair was thrown by one of the suspects, which broke the light fixture and the window. KEARNS went on to explain that a majority of the Irish Travelling Community were trying to stop the fight between the two suspects but the damage had already been caused to his property. PC DELLER asked KEARNS if he would be willing to support police action in providing a statement and attending court, however, he stated that he wasn't and he would arrange for a friend to fix the window tomorrow.</p>
