N103N 1947NA & 1858NA Officers attended NORTH EIGHT PUB in relation to a call stating members of the travelling community were attending the pub for a wake to which they had become extremely drunk and were refusing to leave. VIW had told the customers that they will not be drinking any more in the pub and had told

	them to leave by ringing the bell to which she approached the males in the group and said to leave. However, one of the SUS had grabbed her arm and told her they were refusing to leave to which VIW grabbed his arm off of her. VIW had told them again to which he grabbed hold of her arm again and shouted at her. VIW became scared and rang the police due to the managers instructions. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with VIW who did not wish to provide a statement however just wanted the customers to leave the pub as they were continuing to refuse to leave. After around 5 minutes officers had managed to get the customers to leave the pub to which they were able to close the pub.
