	one of the chairs across the road on to ST MARYS ROAD N8. It is then apparent one of the SUS had thrown the chair into the pub causing the window to smash. The window that smashed is the lower window on the side of the pub on ST MARYS ROAD N8. Officers arrived on scene to which all the SUS had left the scene, After gaining contact with the landlady, she had stated she will be reviewing the CCTV and will check to see who the suspects were that caused the incident. Officers sent the victim a link on evidence.com after she has reviewed the CCTV. Victim has provided a statement in relation to what has happened and will be placed on the media manager card.
