Roads Proposed Dedicated Disabled Bay - ******

Dear Occupier,

Due to parking pressures in the Borough, Dedicated Disabled Parking Bays are one of the concessions being offered by the Council to accommodate residents with severe walking impairments and those residents who cannot travel far to their vehicle. Each applicant who meets the required criteria within the Disabled Parking Place Policy, which has been set by the Council, is entitled to one Bay for one nominated vehicle. No vehicle other than the applicant's or their nominated driver's will be permitted to park within the Dedicated Bay.

It is as a result of this Policy that a Dedicated Disabled Bay is proposed outside ****. The bay is intended to provide the eligible resident ease of access to and from their property. The installation of the mentioned Dedicated Disabled Parking Bays is considered necessary to improve quality of living for the person of which the bay is intended for.
