Public Engagement on Parking Controls

Extension of Hornsey North East Controlled Parking Arrangements

Introduction

We are writing to ask for your views on the extension of Hornsey North East parking arrangements in your street.

Why we are engaging with you

Residents of Southview Road and Hawthorn Road have told us that they are finding it difficult to park near their homes due to parking pressures created by those outside the area, who take advantage of the current free or unrestricted parking arrangements. We would like to know if you want us to work with you to address these pressures.

What we are proposing

We are writing to ask for your views on Southview Road, Hawthorn Road, Northview Road and properties on the north side of High Street becoming part of the Hornsey North East controlled parking zone (CPZ). This would provide safe, managed parking spaces for residents and their visitors.

If the majority of those responding favour the extension of the Hornsey North East CPZ with current operational times of Monday to Friday, 10am to 2pm the Council will progress to the next stage which is statutory consultation. However, if the majority of those responding do not want parking controls, the Council will likely not take any further action. Other changes on offer

Dedicated disabled parking bays (those that can only be used by one vehicle registration) are one of the benefits being offered by the Council to help residents with severe walking impairments and those residents who cannot travel far to their vehicle. The bays are intended to provide eligible residents with easy access to and from their homes and ensure sufficient room to manoeuvre in and out of their vehicle. If, however, you do not have access to the internet, you can request a dedicated disabled parking bay under Q5 within the questionnaire.

What happens next?

Our estimated timeline to progress this project is detailed below.

- June/July 2025: Council Officers will analyse responses and prepare recommendations for reporting.
- August/September 2025: Officers will prepare a report with recommendations which will be submitted for a decision to a key officer following consultation with the relevant Cabinet Member.
- October 2025: We will write to you to update you on the public engagement and decision outcome. If changes are required and approved, we will progress to statutory consultation.
