Statutory Consultation

Proposed Zebra Crossing on Mary Neuner Road, between Alington House and Blenheim Mansions, N8

Dear Resident or Business,

Haringey Council is committed to making the borough safer and more accessible for everyone. Following the delivery of the new housing development on Mary Neuner Road, the council has received requests from the local community for a safe crossing point linking the two green spaces and Clarendon children's play area.

In response to the above, and to encourage walking, the council is proposing a new zebra crossing on Mary Neuner Road, which will provide a clearly defined crossing point and give pedestrians the right of way over motor traffic, enabling them to cross the road safely.

Details of the proposal are listed below and set out on the plan attached:

- Introduce a zebra crossing on Mary Neuner Road, between Alington House and Blenheim Mansion (N8), including associated lighting equipment and road markings.

Statutory consultation period

To introduce the proposals and legally enforce their use, we are required to enter into a period of consultation known as 'statutory consultation'.

The statutory consultation on these changes will begin on **10th December 2025**. This provides a 30-day period for anyone wishing to object or submit representations to these proposals. 
The closing date for objections and submissions to be received by the Council via the portal or email by **9th January 2026**.
