Dear Haringey Licensing Team,

I hope you are well.

I am writing to inform you that I strongly object to KFC's licensing application to extend their opening hours until 4am everyday.

Firstly, there is absolutely no need for this extension due to the extensive number of similar food businesses which already operate during these timings, such as McDonald's, Dixy Chicken, Selekt Chicken and Bites Chicken. There also many other food shops, such as kebab shops, which are open in these same hours. Therefore, the extension of KFC's opening hours would only create a hot-spot for further public nuisance and loitering, which can be detrimental to other local businesses on the High Road.

Additionally, this could lead to a hot-spot for children to loiter at night and become an area involved in crime and disorder, such as drug dealing, causing further nuisance.

Moreover, this extension would lead to greater noise pollution in this area and Haringey does not need this. There would be further rubbish and disturbance to the local residents from the potential hot spot this area would become if the hours are to be extended.

I also strongly believe that FT Foods Limited should be investigated to assess for any past issues with other locations or any past breaches of licensing. Under their existing planning permission, they are currently allowed to operate until 10:30/11pm and this is how they should remain.

I hope this matter will be resolved fairly keeping in mind your local residents and businesses who are the heart of Haringey.
