## PROPOSED RAISED ZEBRA CROSSING – HOLMDALE TERRACE N15

**The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No.\*\*\*) Order 202\***

**The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. \*\*\*) Order 202\***

**Notice is hereby given** that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey proposes to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and under Section 23 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and section 90a and 90c of the Highways Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 to introduce a raised zebra crossing on Holmdale Terrace N15.

**The general effect of the Orders** would be:

- 1) To revoke approximately 19 metres of permit holders only parking on both sides of Holmdale Terrace N15, from a point outside the common boundary of No.1/2, heading northeast to outside No.3.
- 2) To revoke no waiting at any time restrictions on Holmdale Terrace N15:
  - i. Northwest side: Outside No.1
  - ii. Southeast side: Opposite No.1 continuing southwest opposite the junction with Varty Road

The above parking changes are required to facilitate the installation of a proposed raised zebra crossing and associated zig-zag markings on Holmdale Terrace N15, on which vehicles would be prohibited from stopping at all times. These will be placed on the carriageway either side of the crossing, approximately 17.4 metres in either direction. The centre of the crossing will be located outside property No.1 and will be raised by extending the end of the existing raised table at this location north-eastwards by approximately 9.5 metres. The width between the crossing give way lines will be 9.5 metres and the crossing will be supported by footway buildouts on the southeastern side of the carriageway opposite No.1 to No.3.
