Statutory Consultation

Proposed Pedestrian and Cycle improvements on Tynemouth Road (Broad Lane – Copperfield Drive), N15

Dear Resident/Business,

As part of Council's plan to improve pedestrian and cyclists' safety and accessibility in the borough, we are proposing changes on Tynemouth Road between Broad Lane and Copperfield Drive. Details of the measures being proposed are listed below and set out on the plan attached:

- Extend the footways on Spondon Road and Cunningham Road where they meet Tynemouth Road. This will provide a level surface for pedestrians crossing these side roads by reducing motor vehicle speeds as they turn in and out of these roads.

These proposals will result in the loss of one of resident permit parking space on Spondon Road and a 2m reduction of resident permit parking on Cunningham Road. These will be replaced with double yellow lines.

- Raised table at the junction of Tynemouth Road and Antill Road, providing a level surface for pedestrians and cyclist to cross the junction. This will require the removal of the existing speed hump on Antill Road south of its junction with Tynemouth Road.
- Extend of the northern footway on Tynemouth Road where it joins Broad Lane, improving safety by reducing the crossing distance for pedestrians and reducing the speed of motor vehicles as they turn in and out of the road.

Statutory consultation period

To introduce these proposals and legally enforce its use, we are required to enter into a period of consultation known as 'statutory consultation'. This is the legal part of the process and takes the form of a public notice advertised in the local press, London Gazette. In addition, the public notice will be erected on a post close to the proposed change, informing the public of the Council's intentions.

The statutory consultation on these changes will begin on **7th January 2026**. This provides a 21-day period for anyone wishing to object to the proposals. You must provide a reason/s for your objection. Please ensure that **2025-T38 – Tynemouth Road Proposals** is included within the subject title of your email or letter.

The closing date for objections to be received by the Council via the portal, email or post is **28th January 2026**.

What happens next?

At the end of the statutory consultation period, all objections will be considered by the Council before a decision is made on whether to introduce the changes proposed. I will write to you again to inform you of this decision and timescales for implementing, should the proposed change be approved.
