## Statutory Consultation

### Proposed Zebra Crossing on St Ann's Road to the west of La Rose Lane, N15

Dear Resident or Business,

Following requests from the local community, and as part of the St Ann's Hospital development to improve pedestrian access to the area, the Council is proposing to introduce a zebra crossing on St Ann's Road to the west of La Rose Lane.

The proposed zebra crossing will provide a clearly defined crossing point and will give pedestrians the right of way over traffic, enabling them to cross the road safely, which will assist in reducing road traffic accidents.

Details of the proposal are listed below and set out on the plan attached:

- Removal the pedestrian refuge island and introduce a zebra crossing on a raised flat-topped speed hump, including associated lighting equipment and road markings.
- Removal of the "School Keep Clear" markings on the northern side of the carriageway.

### Statutory consultation period

To introduce the proposals and legally enforce their use, we are required to enter into a period of consultation known as 'statutory consultation'. This is the legal part of the process and takes the form of a public notice advertised in the local press, London Gazette and visible locations within the affected area to inform the public of the Council's intentions.

The statutory consultation on these changes will begin on **29<sup>th</sup> October 2025**. This provides a 21-day period for anyone wishing to object or respond to those proposals. 
The closing date for objections and submissions to be received by the Council via the portal, email or post is **19<sup>th</sup> November 2025**.
