Statutory Consultation:

Watermead Way and Hale Road N17 - Proposed 20mph Limit

The proposed measures aim to improve road safety and pedestrian accessibility:

- Reduce the speed limit on Watermead Way (south of Burdock Road) and Hale Road (East of The Hale) from 30mph to 20mph
- Provide new speed tables and speed cushions on Watermead Way
- Provide new 20mph traffic signs and road markings

Ashley Road	Support	We're in favour of a 20mph speed limit on Watermead Way and Hale Road. A lot of children need to use the traffic crossings in the area to get to school and also to Tottenham Hale station's transport hub. We'd further propose a pedestrian light-controlled crossing north of Hale Road at the mouth of Park View Rd. in order to have safe access to the new GP surgery.
Ashley Road Ashley Road	Support Support	NOISE CAMERAS! Large motorbikes will still speed along a lot and produce excessive noise when negotiating the humps and also immediately after the 20mph limit section ends.
Ashley Road Ashley Road	Support Support	Very supportive of 20mph limit. Just this week, we've seen 2 accidents on this stretch of road, and many times I have seen motorists jumping / ignoring the red light crossing in front of Cygnet Way. Any additional safety measures are welcomed - even including revenue raisers like enforcement cameras. Hundreds of children come to school every day across this road.
Station Road	Support	The scheme will help with traffic noise. However, the main problem that needs addressing is that of loose manhole covers along Hale Road up to Cygnet Way. These loose covers create a lot of noise as vehicles drive over them. Several residents have sent in complaints, but no action has been taken. This is a major cause of noise nuisance and it keeps many residents awake at night. These issues need to be addressed as part of your ongoing works here.
Watermead Way	Support	Fantastic news. Almost every day when crossing at the lights on Watermead way there are cars who speed round the corner (40+ mph easily) and almost hit pedestrians. One was hit recently at the lights. It is very common to see drivers speeding round the corner, not notice the crossing is at a red light, and fly straight through it almost hitting pedestrians. It is very scary crossing the road sometimes with how fast drivers go round the corner and up towards the overpass section of road. Very glad to see the 20mph limit coming into place, although I think it is borderline needing a speed camera in place due to speeding being a daily occurrence. Thanks
