PROPOSED 20MPH SPEED LIMIT & TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES – A1055 HALE ROAD & WATERMEAD WAY N17

The Haringey (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (Amendment No. ***) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey proposes to make the above mentioned Order under sections 84 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and under section 90a and 90c of the Highways Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 to introduce raised speed tables and speed cushions on A1055 Watermead Way N17.

The general effect of order will be to implement a 20mph Speed Limit on the lengths of road detailed below:

Road	Description
A1055 Hale Road N17	Between a point outside No.1 Hale Road and Watermead Way.
A1055 Watermead Way N17	Between Hale Road and a point 27 metres north of the northern kerb line of Burdock Road.

Raised speed tables and speed cushions will also be introduced on A1055 Watermead Way N17, each with a maximum height of 75mm and the centre of the features at the following approximate locations:

- A) Speed tables (carriageway width except for drainage channels at either side):
- 1) On Watermead Way, approximately 28 metres southwest from the eastern kerb line of Cygnet Way, a length of approximately 10 metres.
 - 2) On Watermead Way, approximately 29 metres south from the southern kerb line of Burdock Road, a length of approximately 10 metres.
- B) Speed cushions:
- 1) On Watermead Way, approximately 135 metres south from the southern kerb line of Burdock Road (3 speed cushions, 1 per carriageway lane). Approximate widths of 1.6 metres and lengths of 2 metres.
