1	Object	There's too much footfall in the area, it'd make it extremely difficult for cars to go by creating more traffic on Gladstone Avenue.
2	Other / Don't know	Risk of obstructive parking too close to the zebra crossing. Whilst broadly supporting the scheme, we have the following comment: 1) The controlled area is very short and may lead to delivery drivers or other vehicles parking too close to the crossing, would you consider extending it to the junction mouth? The zig zags need not be the same length on both sides and regulations allow for such flexibility.
