Further to the Noise Nuisance and Licensing Team's representation of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2026 regarding the above Premises licence application. Officers visited the above business on the 17<sup>th</sup> April 2026 at 23:14 hours. The business was open and customers were seated at the tables. Some of the customers had what appeared to be full wine glasses in front of them with bottles of wine. Other customers had what appeared to be bottles of beer in front of them. The fridge behind the counter was turned on and was full of alcohol and some of the alcohol matched what was within the fridge. However, it was partially covered with a sheet. David Wood looked in the bin behind the Fridge and it was full of empty beer cans and wine bottles. Officers also noticed patrons leave and return with black carrier bags of alcohol. Craig Bellringer photographed post it notes on the counter that had the prices of food and alcohol on them (Appendix 1A, 1B, 1C). The post it notes appeared to be used to record orders. After Craig photographed the post it notes, staff took them away. Janet Nyantaki was present at the business. We asked her what was taking place and she stated that alcohol was not being sold. Officers then left the property.

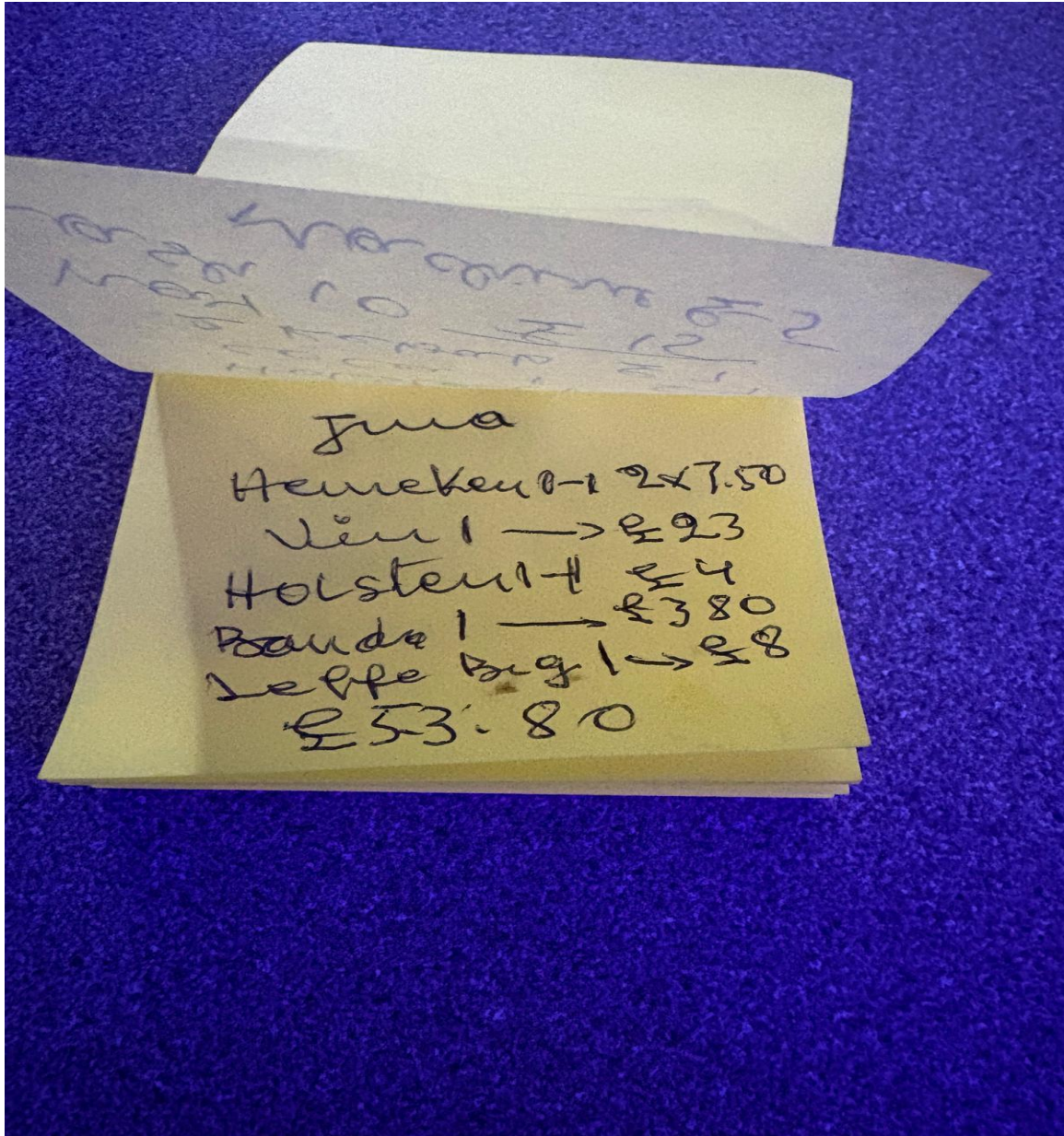
