STATUTORY CONSULTATION

Proposed Parking and Highway changes -Haringey Heartlands– N8 and N22

Dear Resident or Business,

Further to the letter we sent you in June 2026 to inform you of the statutory consultation that commenced on 17th June 2026 for the proposed parking and highway changes in the Haringey Heartlands area, we have been made aware of an error in the plan we sent you (INSERT 2).

This letter is to inform you that the plan incorrectly labelled the building as 'BEELEY HOUSE' when it should have stated '**GOLDCREST HOUSE**'. A revised plan showing the amendment is included at the back of this letter. The bus stop shown at this location is for information only and part of this consultation, as it has been approved as part of a previous consultation.

At the end of this statutory consultation period, all objections and representations will be considered by the Council before a decision is made on whether to introduce the changes proposed.
